Bible Scripture

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" John 1:29 (ESV)

Every day, we have people watching our behavior and listening to what we say. If we stay faithful to Jesus,, the Lamb, they may want to know more about the One Who takes away their sins. Who knows how many souls will come into the kingdom when we live each day in a way that says, "Behold Jesus!" We can begin today to share Christ with others.

Walking with Jesus: Think of someone you know who needs to meet Jesus. Decide how you will show Him to that person.

[How to] RISE ABOVE YOUR CIRCUMSTANCES

If we have FAITH in the Lord, we will be able to *rise above* our circumstances. Let me prove my point by referring to the story of Peter and the disciples when they were caught in a horrific storm.¹

Jesus ordered them to get in the boat and row to the other side of The Sea of Galilee. He remained behind.

By the time they had rowed about halfway, suddenly a fierce storm rose up. It was in the middle of the night and they were being tossed to-and-fro. Even though Peter, Andrew, James, and John were experienced fishermen and were expert sailors, they couldn't get the boat under control. All the disciples FEARED they were going to capsize and die.

Had they forgotten what Jesus had said: *"Row to the other side!"* Had they lost their faith in the face of the storm? They were beginning to panic and lose hope—fearing for their lives.

Then they saw what they thought was a ghost-like figure walking on the water. They *"cried out in FEAR!"* But then Jesus spoke to them and told them to *"not be afraid."* Impulsive Peter decides he wants to test the waters and asks Jesus if he can come (walk) to Him. Peter often acts before he thinks! Jesus told him he could come. So he jumped out of the boat and—believe it or not—he began to walk on the water, too!

He, however, began to SINK when he took his eyes off of Jesus. Here is the lesson Jesus was trying to teach Peter: Keep your eyes (focused) on Me!!! Trust in Me and don't rely on your own strength. However, when he ran out of his own faith, he depended upon the faith of Christ Jesus. Peter had started walking on the water on his own strength, which was not sufficient.

When in DOUBT—cry out to the Lord.

That's just what Peter did...he cried out *"Lord, save me!"* He didn't call on help from the other disciples (who remained huddled together in the boat—frozen in fear).

He didn't ask for a life preserver....he asked for "The Preserver of Life!"

Immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and lifted Peter up and they both walked together back to the boat. Then He spoke, “O you of little faith, why did you doubt?” And then He calmed the storm as well as calming the disciples.

Peter BELIEVED in Jesus...but he was still filled with much UNBELIEF! As it reads in Mark 9:24, “I believe, but help me with my unbelief” and as we learn to walk more closely to the Lord, our faith will increase and we will learn to TRUST HIM more.

Remember, it’s one thing to live UNDER your circumstances (and lead a defeated life), but it’s another thing to RISE ABOVE your circumstances (and live a victorious life).

God allows certain trials and storms to come into our lives in order to test our level of faith. Don’t stay on the beach...get in the water....go out deeper, and go through the troubled waters with the assurance that you can trust Him to help you in the crisis and increase your faith in the process.
